

Scriptural Evidence in ONE GOD

Note: Anytime the word LORD appears in the Old Testament in all Capitals, the Hebrew “tetragramaton” YHVH was used, indicating that “Jehovah” God is intended.

Deuteronomy 6:3-5 “Hear therefore, O Israel, and observe to do it; that it may be well with thee, and that ye may increase mightily, as the LORD God of thy fathers hath promised thee, in the land that floweth with milk and honey. Hear, O Israel: **The LORD our God is one LORD:** And thou shalt love the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might.”

The Bible explains that by the mouth of 2 or 3 let every word be established. So in following along in the word, we should be able to prove without a doubt the consistency of the Godhead through the scriptures. If the God of the old and the Jesus referenced in the new are different or the same, then this should become very clear as we peel apart the scriptures and see what God has given us.

Isaiah 9:6-7 “For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and **his name shall be called** Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace. Of the increase of his government and peace there shall be no end, upon the throne of David, and upon his kingdom, to order it, and to establish it with judgment and with justice from henceforth even for ever.”

3 Absolutes concerning the Godhead:

1) NO EQUALS **Mark 12:28-29** “And one of the scribes came, and having heard them reasoning together, and perceiving that he had answered them well, asked him, **Which is the first commandment of all?** And Jesus answered him, The first of all the commandments is, Hear, O Israel; The Lord our God is one Lord”

There is no other doctrine in the Bible as important as this one. It is the FIRST commandment. All others are built and founded on this one. So if we miss this one and try to grasp and hold one of the others in the Bible then we may not truly have ever had a good handle on them whether it be salvation, living life, loving our neighbors, treating our spouses, etc.

Isaiah 44:8 “have not I told thee from that time, and have declared it? ye are even my witnesses. **Is there a God beside me? yea, there is no God; I know not any.**” And do we know or presume to know more than God???

2) NO EXCEPTIONS **I Timothy 3:16** “And **without controversy** great is the mystery of godliness: **God was** manifest in the flesh, justified in the Spirit, seen of angels, preached unto the Gentiles, believed on in the world, received up into glory.”

The subject of the Godhead is not some great mystery that is open for private interpretation, debate, or just a matter of semantics – but it is an evident truth given by the Word of God. The only controversy can come from darkness because “darkness comprehended it not” when referring to the light [John1].

Acts 4:12 “Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is **none other name** under heaven given among men, **whereby we must be saved.**”

3) No Excuses **Romans 1:20** “For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, **being understood by the things that are made, even his eternal power and Godhead; so that they are without excuse**”

As much as people allow tradition to shape their thinking and cloud their judgment in regards to things concerning God and eternity – we must understand that the scripture is clear and gives us the power to understand!!! Several in the judgment will claim ignorance, but the scripture from Romans will judge – for it says that they are without excuse.

Jude warned us to “earnestly contend for the faith once delivered to the saints”. Since this faith and doctrine has been delivered wholly and intact there is no room for improvement or change in it. We simply must stop looking for excuses and earnestly contend for this truth.

Earnestly Contending for the Truth:

The scripture claims that ye shall know the truth and that the truth shall set you free. I am not sure about you but I will be earnestly (diligently) contending (fighting to make known) for these truths. Consider this scripture in the light of God's word.

Joel 2:27-32 "And ye shall know that I am in the midst of Israel, and that I am the LORD your God, and none else: and my people shall never be ashamed. **And it shall come to pass afterward, that I will pour out my spirit upon all flesh;** and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions: And also upon the servants and upon the handmaids in those days will I pour out my spirit. And I will shew wonders in the heavens and in the earth, blood, and fire, and pillars of smoke. The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood, before the great and terrible day of the LORD come. And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on the name of the LORD shall be delivered: for in mount Zion and in Jerusalem shall be deliverance, as the LORD hath said, and in the remnant whom the LORD shall call."

We find ourselves seeing the fulfillment of this scriptural prophecy from Joel on the day of Pentecost with the outpouring of the promise that Jesus told them to tarry in Jerusalem "until ye be endued with power from on high". Peter when he began to preach, spoke unto them citing this verse of scripture and said that this is THAT! But what was Joel really saying in verse 28, after what shall all of this come to pass? The simple answer is verse 27, but lets look at it again. It says, "ye shall know that **I** am in the midst of Israel, and that **I** am the LORD your God, and **none else**". The terms from the Old Testament meaning Lord God were Jehovah and Elohim, so in simplicity this scripture is saying that after Jehovah Elohim has been in the midst of Israel, then HE will pour out his spirit upon them. SO, that Jehovah Elohim that people want to tell you is the first person in the Godhead is actually the same as Jesus for it was Jesus/Jehovah Elohim that walked the face of this earth in the midst of HIS people for 33.5 years. And upon his death, burial and resurrection – he poured out HIS spirit upon them!!!

"Is there really only one, but I have always been told that there were 3 co-equal, co-eternal, co-powerful, etc..." And maybe you have been told that but who are we to argue with God and His word, what about this set of scriptures:

Deut 32:39 "See now that I, even I, am he, and there is no god with me"

None With

II Sam 7:22 "there is none like thee, neither is there any God beside thee"

None Like

Isaiah 43:10 "before me there was no God formed, neither shall there be after me"

None Before/None After

Isaiah 43:11 "I, even I, am the LORD; and beside me there is no saviour."

None Beside

Mark 12:32 "for there is one God; and there is none other but he"

None OTHER!

The "I AM":

- Exodus 3:14** "And God said unto Moses, **I AM THAT I AM**: and he said, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, **I AM** hath sent me unto you."
- Isaiah 43:13** "Yea, before the day was **I am** he; and there is none that can deliver out of my hand: I will work, and who shall let it?"
- John 8:56-59** "Your father Abraham rejoiced to see my day: and he saw it, and was glad. Then said the Jews unto him, Thou art not yet fifty years old, and hast thou seen Abraham? Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, **Before Abraham was, I am**. Then took they up stones to cast at him: but Jesus hid himself, and went out of the temple, going through the midst of them, and so passed by."

Lord of the Sabbath:

- Leviticus 19:3** "Ye shall fear every man his mother, and his father, and **keep my sabbaths**: I am the LORD your God."
- Matthew 12:8** "For the **Son of man is Lord even of the sabbath** day."

The ONLY Saviour:

- Isaiah 12:2** "Behold, **God is my salvation**; I will trust, and not be afraid: for the LORD JEHOVAH is my strength and my song; he also is become my salvation."
- Isaiah 43:3, 10-11** "For I am the LORD thy God, the Holy One of Israel, **thy Saviour**. I gave Egypt for thy ransom, Ethiopia and Seba for thee.... Ye are my witnesses, saith the LORD, and my servant whom I have chosen: that ye may know and believe me, and understand that I am he: before me there was no God formed, neither shall there be after me. I, even I, am the LORD; and **beside me there is no saviour**."
- Isaiah 45:15,21** "Verily thou art a God that hidest thyself, O God of Israel, **the Saviour**. Tell ye, and bring them near; yea, let them take counsel together: who hath declared this from ancient time? who hath told it from that time? have not I the LORD? and there is no God else beside me; **a just God and a Saviour**; there is none beside me."
- Isaiah 25:8-9** "**He will swallow up death in victory**; and the Lord GOD will wipe away tears from off all faces; and the rebuke of his people shall he take away from off all the earth: for the LORD hath spoken it. And it shall be said in that day, Lo, this is our God; we have waited for him, and **he will save us**: this is the LORD; we have waited for him, we will be glad and rejoice in his salvation."
- Isaiah 43:16,25** "The saith the LORD..... I, even I, am he that **blotteth out thy transgressions** for mine own sake, and **will not remember thy sins**."
- I Corinthians 15:54-57** "So when this corruptible shall have put on incorruption, and this mortal shall have put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written, **Death is swallowed up in victory**. O death, where is thy sting? O grave, where is thy victory? The sting of death is sin; and the strength of sin is the law. But thanks be to God, which giveth us the **victory through our Lord Jesus Christ**."
- Matthew 1:20-23** "But while he thought on these things, behold, the angel of the Lord appeared unto him in a dream, saying, Joseph, thou son of David, fear not to take unto thee Mary thy wife: for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Ghost. And she shall bring forth a son, and **thou shalt call his name JESUS: for he shall save his people from their sins**. Now all this was done, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken of the Lord by the prophet, saying, Behold, a virgin shall be with child, and shall bring forth a son, and they shall call his name Emmanuel, which being interpreted is, **God with us**."

Luke 2:10-11 "And the angel said unto them, Fear not: for, behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy, which shall be to all people. For unto you is born this day in the city of David **a Saviour**, which is Christ the Lord."

Phillipians 3:20 "For our conversation is in heaven; from whence also **we look for the Saviour, the Lord Jesus Christ:**"

Titus 2:13 "Looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the great God and **our Saviour Jesus Christ;**"

John the Forerunner:

Isaiah 40:3 "The voice of him that **crieth in the wilderness, Prepare ye the way of the LORD**, make straight in the desert a highway for our God."

Malachi 3:1 "Behold, **I will send my messenger, and he shall prepare the way before me:** and the Lord, whom ye seek, shall suddenly come to his temple, even the messenger of the covenant, whom ye delight in: behold, he shall come, saith the LORD of hosts."

John 1:23-24 "He said, **I am the voice of one crying in the wilderness**, Make straight the way of the Lord, as said the prophet Esaias [Isaiah]. And they which were sent were of the Pharisees. And they asked him, and said unto him, Why baptizest thou then, if thou be not that Christ, nor Elias, neither that prophet? John answered them, saying, I baptize with water: but there standeth one among you, whom ye know not; **He it is, who coming after me is preferred before me**, whose shoe's latchet I am not worthy to unloose. These things were done in Bethabara beyond Jordan, where John was baptizing. The next day **John seeth Jesus** coming unto him, and saith, Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world. **This is he of whom I said, After me cometh a man which is preferred before me: for he was before me.** And I knew him not: but that he should be made manifest to Israel, therefore am I come baptizing with water. And John bare record, saying, I saw the Spirit descending from heaven like a dove, and it abode upon him. And I knew him not: but he that sent me to baptize with water, the same said unto me, Upon whom thou shalt see the Spirit descending, and remaining on him, the same is he which baptizeth with the Holy Ghost. And I saw, and bare record that this is the Son of God."

Mark 1:1-3 "The beginning of the gospel of Jesus Christ, the Son of God; As it is written in the prophets, Behold, **I send my messenger before thy face, which shall prepare thy way before thee.** The voice of one crying in the wilderness, Prepare ye the way of the Lord, make his paths straight."

Luke 1:76 "And thou, child, shalt be called the prophet of the Highest: **for thou shalt go before the face of the Lord to prepare his ways;**"

The HOLY One:

Isaiah 10:20 "And it shall come to pass in that day, that the remnant of Israel, and such as are escaped of the house of Jacob, shall no more again stay upon him that smote them; but shall stay upon the LORD, **the Holy One** of Israel, in truth."

Isaiah 43:3, 14-15 "For I am the LORD thy God, **the Holy One** of Israel, thy Saviour: I gave Egypt for thy ransom, Ethiopia and Seba for thee. Thus saith the LORD, your redeemer, the **Holy One** of Israel; For your sake I have sent to Babylon, and have brought down all their nobles, and the Chaldeans, whose cry is in the ships. I am the LORD, **your Holy One**, the creator of Israel, your King."

Isaiah 47:4 "As for our redeemer, the LORD of hosts is his name, **the Holy One** of Israel."

Ezekiel 39:7 "So will I make my holy name known in the midst of my people Israel; and I will not let them pollute my holy name any more: and the heathen shall know that I am the LORD, **the Holy One** in Israel."

Acts 2:27 "Because thou wilt not leave my soul in hell, neither wilt thou suffer thine **Holy One** to see corruption."

Mark 1:24 "Saying, Let us alone; what have we to do with thee, thou Jesus of Nazareth? art thou come to destroy us? I know thee who thou art, **the Holy One of God.**"

Acts 3:35 "Wherefore he saith also in another psalm, Thou shalt not suffer **thine Holy One** to see corruption."

John 14:16-17,26 "And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever; Even the Spirit of truth; whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him: but ye know him; for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you. But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you."

Isaiah 44:6 "Thus saith the LORD the King of Israel, and his redeemer the LORD of hosts; **I am the first, and I am the last;** and beside me there is no God."

Isaiah 43:13 "Yea, before the day was I am he; and there is none that can deliver out of my hand: I will work, and who shall let it?"

Isaiah 48:12 "Hearken unto me, O Jacob and Israel, my called; I am he; **I am the first, I also am the last.**"

Micah 5:2 "But thou, Bethlehem Ephratah, though thou be little among the thousands of Judah, yet out of thee shall he come forth unto me that is to be ruler in Israel; whose goings forth have been from of old, from everlasting."

Revelation 1:4 "John to the seven churches which are in Asia: Grace be unto you, and peace, from him **which is, and which was, and which is to come;** and from the seven Spirits which are before his throne;"

Deuteronomy 10:17 "For the LORD your God is God of gods, and **Lord of lords,** a great God, a mighty, and a terrible, which regardeth not persons, nor taketh reward:"

Revelation 19:11-16 "And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war. His eyes were as a flame of fire, and on his head were many crowns; and he had a name written, that no man knew, but he himself. And he was clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: and his name is called The Word of God. And the armies which were in heaven followed him upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean. And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron: and he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God. And he hath on his vesture and on his thigh a name written, **KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS.**"

The zeal of the LORD of hosts will perform this."

Micah 5:2 "But thou, Bethlehem Ephratah, though thou be little among the thousands of Judah, yet out of thee shall he come forth unto me that is **to be ruler in Israel**; whose goings forth have been from of old, from everlasting."

Isaiah 11:1 "And there shall come forth a rod out of the stem of Jesse, and **a Branch shall grow out of his roots:**"

Matthew 22:41-45 "While the Pharisees were gathered together, Jesus asked them, Saying, What think ye of Christ? whose son is he? They say unto him, The **Son of David**. He saith unto them, How then doth David in spirit call him Lord, saying, The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit thou on my right hand, till I make thine enemies thy footstool? If David then call him Lord, how is he his son?"

Revelation 22:16 "I Jesus have sent mine angel to testify unto you these things in the churches. **I am the root and the offspring of David**, and the bright and morning star."

Romans 15:12 "And again, Esaias saith, There shall **be a root of Jesse**, and he that shall rise to reign over the Gentiles; in him shall the Gentiles trust."

Luke 1:32-33, 35 "He shall be great, and shall be called the Son of the Highest: and the Lord God shall **give unto him the throne of his father David**. And he shall reign over the house of Jacob for ever; and of his kingdom there shall be no end... And the angel answered and said unto her, The Holy Ghost shall come upon thee, and the power of the Highest shall overshadow thee: therefore also that holy thing which shall be born of thee shall be called the Son of God."

Acts 2:30 "Therefore being a prophet, and knowing that God had sworn with an oath to him, that of the fruit of his loins, according to the flesh, he would raise up Christ to **sit on his throne;**"

Every Knee Shall Bow:

Isaiah 45:23 "I have sworn by myself, the word is gone out of my mouth in righteousness, and shall not return, That **unto me every knee shall bow, every tongue shall swear:**"

Philippians 2:10-11 "That **at the name of Jesus every knee should bow**, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth; **And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord**, to the glory of God the Father."

Romans 14:9-12 "For to this end Christ both died, and rose, and revived, that he might be Lord both of the dead and living. But why dost thou judge thy brother? or why dost thou set at nought thy brother? for we shall all stand before the judgment seat of Christ. For it is written, As I live, saith the Lord, **every knee shall bow to me, and every tongue shall confess to God**. So then every one of us shall give account of himself to God."

The One with Graven Palms:

Isaiah 49:16 "Behold, **I have graven thee upon the palms of my hands**; thy walls are continually before me."

Zechariah 12:10 "And I will pour upon the house of David, and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the spirit of grace and of supplications: and they shall look **upon me whom they have pierced**, and they shall mourn for him, as one mourneth for his only son, and shall be in bitterness for him, as one that is in bitterness for his firstborn."

John 20:24-28 "But Thomas, one of the twelve, called Didymus, was not with them when Jesus came. The other disciples therefore said unto him, We have seen the Lord. But he said unto them, **Except I shall see in his hands the print of the nails, and put my finger into the print of the nails, and thrust my hand into his side, I will not believe**. And after eight days again his disciples were within, and Thomas with them: then came Jesus, the doors being shut, and stood in the midst, and said, Peace be unto you. Then saith he to Thomas, Reach hither thy finger, and **behold my hands**; and reach hither thy hand, and thrust it into my side: and be not faithless, but believing. And Thomas answered and said unto him, My Lord and my God."

Colossians 2:14 "Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, **nailing it to his cross**;"

God with US:

Psalms 68:18 "Thou hast ascended on high, thou hast led captivity captive: thou hast received gifts for men; yea, for the rebellious also, that **the LORD God might dwell among them**."

Isaiah 7:14 "Therefore the Lord himself shall give you a sign; Behold, a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and **shall call his name Immanuel**."

Matthew 1:23 "Behold, a virgin shall be with child, and shall bring forth a son, and they shall call his name **Emmanuel, which being interpreted is, God with us**."

John 12:45 "And he that **seeth me seeth him that sent me**."

John 14:7-11 "If ye had known me, ye should have known my Father also: and from henceforth ye know him, and have seen him. Philip saith unto him, Lord, shew us the Father, and it sufficeth us. Jesus saith unto him, Have I been so long time with you, and yet hast thou not known me, Philip? **he that hath seen me hath seen the Father**, and how sayest thou then, Shew us the Father? Believest thou not that I am in the Father, and the Father in me? the words that I speak unto you I speak not of myself: but the Father that dwelleth in me, he doeth the works. Believe me that I am in the Father, and the Father in me: or else believe me for the very works' sake."

Rends the Heavens & Mountains Flow Down at His Presence:

- Isaiah 64:1** "Oh that thou [Jehovah] *wouldest rend the heavens, that thou wouldest come down, that the mountains might flow down at thy presence,*"
- Zechariah 14:3-5** "Then shall *the LORD go forth*, and fight against those nations, as when he fought in the day of battle. And *his feet shall stand in that day upon the mount of Olives*, which is before Jerusalem on the east, and the mount of Olives shall cleave in the midst thereof toward the east and toward the west, and there shall be a very great valley; and half of the mountain shall remove toward the north, and half of it toward the south. And ye shall flee to the valley of the mountains; for the valley of the mountains shall reach unto Azal: yea, ye shall flee, like as ye fled from before the earthquake in the days of Uzziah king of Judah: and the LORD my God shall come, and all the saints with thee."
- Jude 14-15** "And Enoch also, the seventh from Adam, prophesied of these, saying, Behold, the *Lord cometh with ten thousands of his saints, To execute judgment upon all*, and to convince all that are ungodly among them of all their ungodly deeds which they have ungodly committed, and of all their hard speeches which ungodly sinners have spoken against him."
- Revelation 19:11-16** "And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war. His eyes were as a flame of fire, and on his head were many crowns; and he had a name written, that no man knew, but he himself. And he was clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: and *his name is called The Word* of God. *And the armies which were in heaven followed him upon white horses*, clothed in fine linen, white and clean. And he hath on his vesture and on his thigh a name written, KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS."

And he had in his right hand seven stars: and out of his mouth went a sharp twoedged sword: and his countenance was as the sun shineth in his strength. And when I saw him, I fell at his feet as dead. And he laid his right hand upon me, saying unto me, Fear not; I am the first and the last: I am he that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, I am alive for evermore, Amen; and have the keys of hell and of death."
